

Traill County Farm Bureau Scholarship

The Traill County Farm Bureau will award four \$500 scholarships annually.

These scholarships will recognize achievements in educational and community involvement in agriculture, as well as North Dakota Farm Bureau involvement.

The following criteria will be used in selecting recipients:

1. The scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior student who is a resident of Traill County or whose parents hold a Traill County Farm Bureau membership. The applicant must also be planning on majoring in agricultural related studies in a college or technical school, or the student has been involved in any agriculture work.
2. Applicants must have achieved a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or better.
3. Preference will be given to applicants whose parents are involved in an ag-related industry and to students involved in ND Farm Bureau.
4. Scholastic honors, goals and ambitions, and work experience will also be considered.

Please include the following with this application:

- Your high school transcript signed by your High School Counselor or Principal.
- A senior picture to be published in the newspaper if selected.
- A letter of character reference. (Optional)
