Spark Creativity - Safety Sam Sayings

Students should create a drawing that shows how they help make the farm a safer place. Some Safety Sam slogans that may help spark some creative ideas, include:

- **No seat, no rider!**
- **Kids, don't go near a PTO!**
- **Don't go with the flow! (grain entrapment)**
- **It makes sense to stay behind the fence! (animal safety)**
- **Hazardous substances! Stay away! Find another place to play!**

Art contest for 4th and 5th graders

Guidelines

- The contest is open to 4th and 5th grade students.
- Artwork should illustrate how the student helps make the farm a safer place, showing safe choices or behaviors on the farm.
- Students should complete the sentence “Farm safety starts with me when I _____.” on the front or back of their artwork.
- Creativity is encouraged! Students may use crayons, markers, colored pencils, paint, or other drawing materials.
- Artwork must be created on an 8.5” x 11” sheet of paper.
- Please include the student’s name, grade, school, and contact information on the back of the artwork.

We will award a winner in each grade in the following categories:

- Creativity and originality of the theme
- Quality of artistic composition and overall design

All four winners will receive \$50 each, and will be published in NDFB's newsletter, *Focus*.
